Drop Point Coordinator Information

Information

Drop point coordinators help solve a major problem in the distribution chain for large, heavy items like livestock feed. Freight is expensive, unloading often requires heavy equipment, and the product is climate-sensitive. Drop points allow us to concentrate delivery to one location, reduce the freight costs, and help customers with offloading.

How does it work? If you decide to become a drop point, we will collect orders for your location from individual customers and put together a delivery. Most of these are delivered once per month. We will schedule that delivery at a time that is convenient for you and share updates to customers via email on when and where to pick up their orders. When the delivery truck arrives, you will unload it and distribute the orders to the customers. Customers should arrive the same day to pick up orders, but occasionally you may need to store orders for a few days in a dry location.

In order to receive a delivery, you must have a total combined order amount of ___ ton(s).

Drop point coordinators do not take orders, organize deliveries or handle payments, Kraut Creek handles all ordering and delivery details. Do not accept payments from customers. We do not want you to become a middle man, it gets messy.

Coordinator Expectations

- Supply location accessible to tractor trailer for deliveries
- Be present to unload deliveries on the scheduled delivery day
- Have a forklift or loader with forks to unload the truck and help customers load up
 - *Need to be able to lift as much as 2500# at a time without unstacking*
- Double check that correct orders go to the correct customer
- Give customers their invoice copies for their order
- Store orders in a dry, safe location if waiting for a customer to pick it up
- Communicate with KC about any delivery or order issues
- Photograph & document any order damages (have delivery driver document also)
- Be a positive representative of Kraut Creek's distribution system
- Provide feedback to Kraut Creek about customer needs & considerations

Compensation

In exchange for being a coordinator you will receive the following:

- 5% credit to your account for the total value of product dropped at your location (*this includes the product from pick up customers as well as your purchases*)
- Marketing materials to share with friends & customers

Agreement

Kraut Creek reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time if the coordinator is not upholding the aforementioned expectations. The coordinator shall give Kraut Creek 30 days written notice if they are no longer interested in being a drop point. The coordinator agrees to waive any liability toward Kraut Creek for damage or injuries to themselves, other customers, their equipment, or buildings that may be incurred during the delivery, loading and unloading of products.
